By signing this Agreement, RFL and the Partner agree to contribute their human and financial resources to help and guide the Student during the scholarship.

Partner Undertaking

The Partner hereby agrees to:

- Contribute financially (as set out in Annex A) towards the Student's studies for the whole duration of the scholarship contract.
- Assess the Student's attendance, grades, wellbeing and life conditions each semester and provide a report to RFL no later than 30 days following the end of the semester.
- Ensure the Student properly and honestly provides any required information to the Partner as part of the semester evaluation process.
- Take the necessary steps to address the Student's needs and support.
- Exchange with the family on the Student's situation, including meeting the parents (or guardian) at least once per year to request their involvement and support.
- Inform RFL of any serious difficulties in the Student's personal life or studies as soon as possible when detected.



Rise for Life Undertaking

Rise for Life hereby agrees to:

- Bridge the Student's financial necessities (as set out in Annex A) to ensure they receive the funds to cover the full sponsored amount (covering the cost of studies and other agreed upon monthly living support), as a complement to the Partner and other financial help the student receives (e.g., Parents, Universities, Vocational centers, companies, individual donators, etc.).
- Have members of the RFL Board/Committee meet with the Partner after each semester to assess each Student receiving a scholarship using the Partner prepared evaluations and work together to agree on any action needed.
- Ensure a member of the RFL Board/Committee meets with the Student (along with the Partner) at least once a year.
- Contribute to actions to make any necessary changes in the studies and environmental needs for the benefit of the Student's life.
- Help as much as possible to connect the Student to social and professional society, using the RFL network for opportunities for higher studies, internships and potential employment.

Student Undertaking

The Student hereby agrees to:

- Apply their best efforts in their studies and achieve minimum grades required to pass to the next year of study and stay in the scholarship program.
- Provide the selection and evaluation materials required by RFL and the Partner in a true and honest way and share any potential issues with the Partner as soon as possible.
- During the course of their studies act as a mentor to another RFL student in an earlier stage of their course, providing advice and guidance as required and within the spirit of the RFL Foundation.
- After graduation, assist another student in the scholarship program and join the RFL student Alumni and be an active member in the community.
- After graduation, make a future moral commitment to give back to others and sponsor (or find a sponsor) at least one student in the future.

Trouble shooting

In the event of any difficulties being experienced by the Student, the Partner should alert RFL as soon as possible and not wait for the next meeting.

Both RFL and the Partner engage in joint actions to address any "serious" issue faced by the Student to find solutions for the Student and the family.



In case of unresolved troubles with a Student's studies, the Partner can propose the use of:

- **Credit 1:** Student can request a change to the course of their studies not later than the end of the first year, and only in cases where the student was attentive and serious to their studies during the year, or
- **Credit 2:** Student can re-take the same year due to personal or family difficulties resulting in bad grades, but only one time and only if the Partner/RFL accepts the reasons that cause the lack of results.

RFL will convey a board meeting to review the Student's case and the Partner's proposal to make a final decision on the future course of action.
